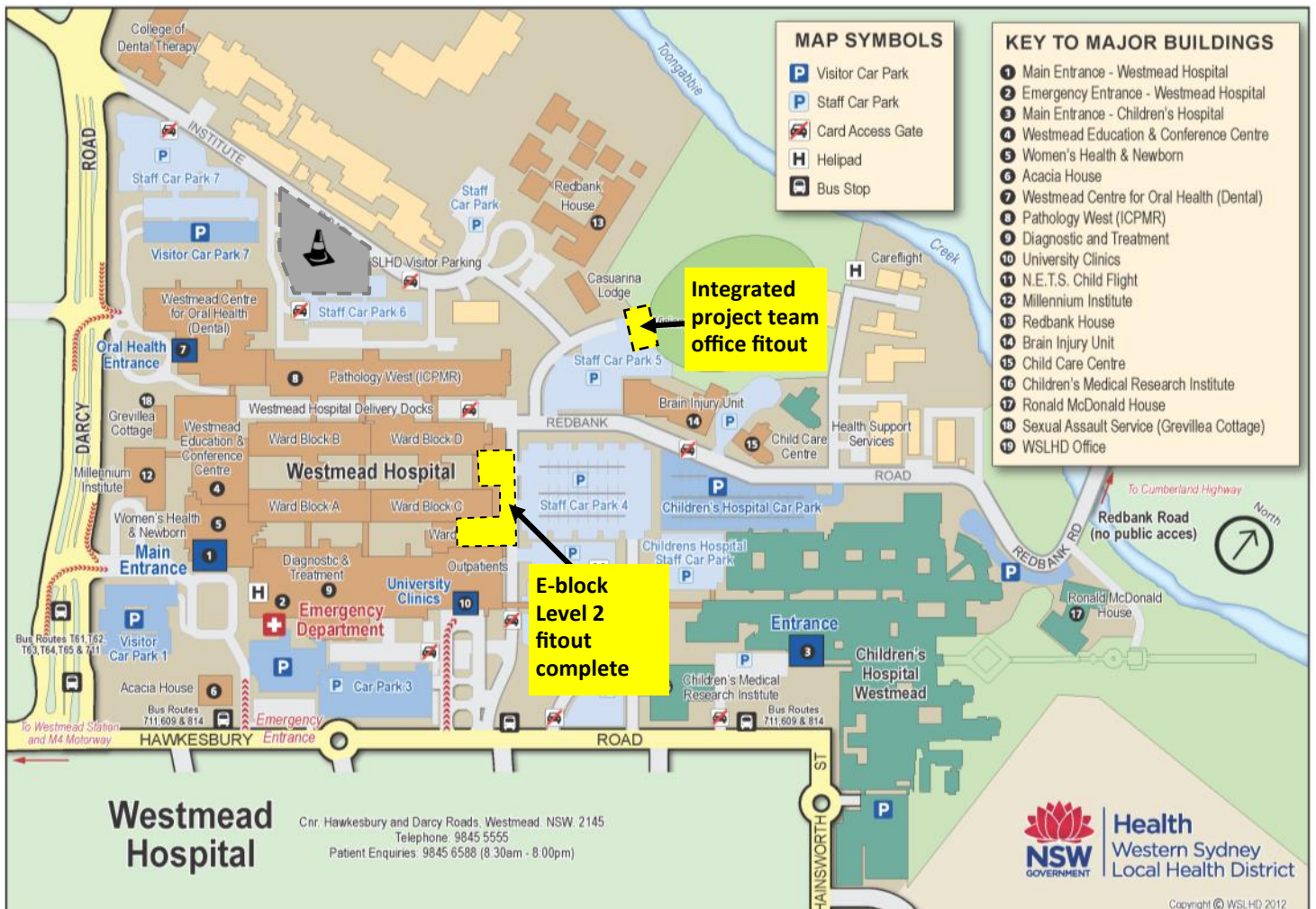
- Round 1 PUGs complete - round 2 on the way.
