

A new unit at Westmead

Westmead Hospital's new inpatient unit (IPU B6) will open on Wednesday, 11 April 2018. The space has been refurbished as part of the Westmead Redevelopment project.

Patients and staff will be relocated to the unit over two days — from Wednesday, 11 April to Thursday, 12 April.

Some wards and the Stomal Therapy Clinic are moving

A number of wards and the Stomal Therapy Clinic are relocating to IPU B6.

- Colorectal surgery — moving from B3c
- Vascular surgery — moving from B3c
- Upper Gastrointestinal (Upper GI) — moving from B3c
- Orthopaedic surgery — moving from D4a
- Trauma — moving from D4a
- Stomal Therapy Clinic — moving from B3c

Moving date and impact for patients

Patients in D4a will be relocated to B6 on Wednesday, 11 April. Patients in B3c will be relocated to B6 on Thursday, 12 April.

Staff will help patients who are relocating during the two moving days. This will include packing and relocating personal belongings to the new unit and ensuring care, meals and showers are scheduled at the appropriate time.

Removalists will be assisting staff to relocate stores and equipment. Please take care in and around the wards and the new unit. If you do not need to be in these areas, please postpone your visit during this peak period. We appreciate your patience and assistance.
