The Westmead Redevelopment will transform the precinct into an innovative, contemporary and integrated centre which can continue to deliver high quality healthcare for decades to come.

Over \$900m has been allocated to the Westmead Redevelopment:

- \$750m for a new hospital building
- \$72m for car parking
- \$95m for The Children's Hospital at Westmead

The new hospital building

The concept design (pictured above) was launched in October 2015, locating the new acute services building in the heart of the Westmead precinct.

The location of the new hospital building will allow better connections for patients and visitors. It will also ensure that the opportunity for greater integration will be realised across the precinct especially between Westmead Hospital, The Children's Hospital at Westmead and the two major research institutes.

Early and enabling works

Early and enabling works are occurring in parallel with the planning and include

electrical upgrades, alternative parking options, road realignments, services diversions, demolition and site clearance.

During the redevelopment, services and access to buildings will be maintained and projects have been carefully staged to ensure there is as little disruption as possible to patients, carers, staff and visitors.

The Westmead precinct

All Westmead precinct partners are working together to help Westmead become a workable, liveable and accessible health district that focuses on integrated healthcare, teaching and research that promotes patient, carer and staff wellbeing and community engagement.

The Westmead precinct has one of the largest concentrations of biomedical, scientific and health-care focused minds in Australia and it will continue to attract staff, students, residents, researchers and visitors from all over the world.

By 2036, the workforce at Westmead is expected to increase from 12,000 to 25,000 and the number of students is expected to grow from less than 2,000 to 6,000.

What's currently being planned

- Emergency

The new hospital building also includes a new main entry and transit lounge for patients to wait in comfort when they are leaving hospital after treatment.

The Westmead Hospital refurbishment program includes:

- Expanded Ambulatory Care
- Gastroenterology
- Aged Care
- Respiratory
- Intensive Care

The new hospital building will be completed in 2020.

Transport and Car Parking

The Westmead Redevelopment aims to build a more livable, workable and accessible precinct.

The long term plan for the Westmead Redevelopment is to ease parking stress by increasing the use of public transport and creating new car parking.

Transport for NSW is committed to delivering a high standard of connectivity and accessibility to Westmead and a range of solutions are being investigated to improve accessibility including strengthening cross-regional bus routes to expand the reach of public transport and improvements to the road, walking and cycling networks.

The Parramatta Light Rail Network has been announced and will connect Westmead to the Parramatta CBD, Sydney Olympic Park and Strathfield. Construction of the network is expected to commence in 2018, with a projected completion date of 2024.

\$72 million has been committed for car parking as part of the Westmead Redevelopment. This includes more than 1,400 additional car parking spaces across the Westmead precinct, a new multi-deck car park, a new modern car park management system, as well as better security, improved lighting, footpaths and CCTV.
